- 2. Key concepts of literary theory, translation theory and teaching methodologies.
- 3. Literary and cultural movements in the French and Francophone World.
- 4. Historical developments in the French and Francophone World.
- 5. Important authors and texts of French and Francophone Literature (19th-21st centuries)

Syllabus for Entrance Test: M.A in French and Francophone Studies

The Entrance Test consists of 100 Multiple Choice Questions of different types including Simple and Multiple Choice, Match-the-Following, Assertion-Reasoning, etc.

The questions will cover the following areas:

- 1. Language use questions including basic comprehension, grammatical categories and vocabulary. The level required is approximately B1-B2 levels of the Common European Framework.
- 2. General awareness questions on the French and Francophone world including areas like history, geography, political events and personalities, current affairs, sports, cinema, music and other art forms, etc.
- 3. Important authors and their works.
- 4. Key literary trends and movements.
- 5. Translation of simple sentences from French-English and English-French.
