

Prof. Shiv Kumar Singh, has been working as a lecturer of Indian Studies and Hindi at *Faculdade de Letras*, University of Portugal since 2009. He was awarded prestigious Camões scholarship of Govt. of Portugal to study Portuguese Language and Cultures in Portugal.
