





Call for Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM)

Erasmus+ KA171 Staff Mobility for Teaching for 2023-24

University of Delhi has received grant under the Erasmus+ KA171 program for academic session 2023-24 (Spring 2024), comprising of Staff Mobility for Teaching (STA) to the partner institution, i.e., University of Malaga (Spain).

Teaching mobility – STA

The objective of the mobility is to encourage higher education institutions to broaden and enrich the range and content of courses they offer.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Full-time academic staff employed at the University of Delhi or its affiliated colleges/institutions can apply for staff mobility.
- Subject area: Education, Humanities (Except Languages), Languages and Philological Sciences.
- Applicants are expected to have knowledge of sufficient foreign language to carry out the activity.

DURATION OF MOBILITY

Mobilities will take place in 5 business days (excluding travel days) per staff. A teaching activity has to comprise a minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The following steps must be followed during the application:

- 1. The Erasmus Staff Mobility application form must be filled in completely.
- 2. For Teaching Mobility, the Mobility Agreement for Teaching must be filled in completely.
- 3. The approval parts in the Teaching Plans must be completed by obtaining the signatures of the relevant persons (of receiving institution). The positions of the persons concerned should be specified. (Dean, Head of Department and/or Director, Head of Unit).
- The selection of the staff, who will participate in the staff mobility activity, will be made by the Erasmus+ 171 Mobility Selection Commission (Dept. of GRS) of University of Delhi. The entire selection process will adhere to criteria of transparency, inclusion, and equal opportunities for applicants and the interinstitutional agreements of the Erasmus+ 171 guidelines.
