



IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR INDIAN STUDENTS

MiDIC is proud to announce that, through collaboration with the International Office of the University of Bologna (DIRI), there will be:

two scholarships available for Indian students

accepted to the Master in Development, Innovation and Change (MiDIC) 2008-2009

The scholarships are provided by

- **Regione Emilia-Romagna (Emilia-Romagna Regional Government)**
- **Bologna Chamber of Commerce**

The MiDIC program itself **will grant total or partial tuition fee waiver.**

Students with Indian citizenship with a 3 or 4-year undergraduate degree may apply for the MiDIC program and the scholarships. Those wishing to apply must submit their application by November 30th, and selection will take place on December 5th. The top two students in the resulting ranking will be awarded with:

1st place student:

Scholarship offered by the Emilia-Romagna Regional Government (10,000 euros): MiDIC program will grant a partial tuition fee waiver of 3,000 Euro

The scholarship will cover **full tuition and fees** and provide the remaining **9,500 euro for the student's living expenses.**

2nd place student:

Scholarship offered by the Bologna Chamber of Commerce (8,000 euro): MiDIC program will grant a total tuition fee waiver of 3,500 Euro

The joint scholarship will cover **full tuition and fees** and provide the remaining **8,000 euro for the student's living expenses.**

MiDIC (www.dse.unibo.it/midic) is an international, interdisciplinary, one year Master program aimed at providing education and training in local development and innovation issues. The Master program is designed for students planning to pursue careers as experts, consultants and professionals within local, national and international organisations - private (profit and non-profit) and public (administrative and research oriented) - acting in contexts of local development processes, both in developed and in developing and less developed countries.

Note: Both scholarships will be available to the recipients upon arrival in Italy (not before) and the payments to the students for living expenses will be distributed over the course of the semesters. The amounts shown above are the total amounts before taxes are deducted. The students receiving the scholarships will not have to pay any tuition or fees to the MiDIC program and will only be responsible for the 10 euro application fee to be paid through the alma welcome system at the time of application (<https://www.almawelcome.unibo.it/almawelcome/home>).
